The Johnson County Central Preschool Program is now accepting registration forms for the 2018-19 school year. Our program serves children three years of age to kindergarten entrance age. A child must be three years of age on or before July 31, 2018 to be enrolled in preschool. All preschool children, regardless of their abilities, disabilities, or the social, linguistic, or economic diversity of the children's families are eligible to be served in our preschool program. If you did not receive a registration letter in the mail, please call the school for more information.

Children that are birth to 5 years old, who are experiencing problems with speech language, cognitive, emotional, and/or physical development or have a disability can receive services through Early Childhood Education Services.
